CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

FEDERAL JOBS (Training Program)
Many Government agencies offer students an opportunity to try their wings in federal service before graduation. Under special work-study programs used in installations throughout the country, students alternate between periods of on-the-job training and study on the campus. These training opportunities are offered primarily to students majoring in engineering and the physical and biological sciences, but a few are found in other fields. These programs enable students to get practical on-the-job experience and decide if they would like to make their careers in public service. At the same time, the agencies observe the students' work and determine if they would make good material for permanent employment.

These positions are filled through examinations announced each year to recruit college students who show promise for development into top-caliber professional workers in scientific and engineering fields. Students may participate in summer employment programs in which on-the-job training is given regular vacations from college, or they may apply for cooperative work-study programs in which the job training is given at other designated intervals during the year. For example, the schedule may call

for six months of on-the-job training and six months of college training each year for 4 years.

Starting salaries range from annual rates of \$2,690 to \$3,415 depending upon the student's academic level. Freshman students entering the program are paid at the rate of \$2,690, while juniors start at the rate of \$3,415.00. Trainees are paid only for the periods of on-the-job training, not while attending college.

As they complete the prescribed work and study requirements, they are given leave to return to college, as they complete the prescribed work and study requirements, they advance to higher salary grades. Upon completion of all requirements for a B.A. degree, they may be promoted to full-time professional positions starting at \$3,670 or more a year.

Actor Sir Cedric Hardwicke Performs At Virginia State

PETERSBURG — Sir Cedric Hardwicke, one of the most distinguished actors of our time, was presented by the Artists Recitals Series Committee of Virginia State College on Tuesday, October 14, in a literary concert entitled "Come Back Stage With Me." His appearance was scheduled for 8:00 p. m. in the Virginia Hall Auditorium.

Born in Worcestershire, England, (now a resident of New York City) Sir Cedric Hardwicke attended the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art and made his debut on the London stage in "THE MONK AND THE WOMAN." Early in his career, he toured South Africa

with the renowned F. R. Benson Shakespeare Company, playing a variety of the Bard's most demanding roles.

Back in England, he played in the now famous George Bernard Shaw play, "BACK TO METHUSELAH." Sir Cedric's rare talent and commanding personality were immediately recognized and he has been in demand for leading roles in New York and London since 1924.

Some of his most well-known characterizations on the English speaking stage have been Caesar in "CAESAR & CLEOPATRA," Captain Andy in "SHOW BOAT," Edward Moulton Barrett in "THE BARRETT'S OF WIMPOLE STREET" and "ANTIGONE"

Shaw University Speaker:

"Make Up Your Mind What You Want To Do," NY Editor Urges

Powell, president and editor of the New York Amsterdam News told Shaw University students on Monday, October 20, that one of the rules for success in life is to make up your mind what to do or to be to accomplish goals and aim toward those goals.
