Supreme Court Ruling Favors Sleeping Car Porters Group

WASHINGTON (AP) — The United States Supreme Court held Monday that the State court has no jurisdiction over union disputes by railroad employees. This ruling, affirmed by the Missouri Supreme Court in January, was upheld by the high court's refusal to review an appeal brought by 10 employees of the Missouri Pacific Railroad Co. against the Brotherhood of Sleeping Car Porters.

The suit was brought by employees who have seniority charge from jobs because of their alleged failure to join the date fixed by the union Brotherhood within 60 days of shop agreement in March 1953. The petitioners claimed that they went beyond the authority of the labor organization, the carrier, and the Railway Labor Act.

They also questioned the manner in which the agreement was executed, claiming that it was issued without their consent, or without notice to them. They further claimed that they were not given an opportunity to be heard on the subject while the Brotherhood had been given an opportunity to discuss it and act upon it at the Brotherhood convention through delegates.

The case was dismissed by a district court on the grounds that it lacked jurisdiction, and held that the National Railroad Adjustment Board has the authority to settle union disputes, to reinstate employees, and rule on damages resulting from the discharge of non-compliance with union membership requirements or union shop contracts.

This ruling was affirmed by the Missouri Supreme Court and left standing by the U. S. Court.
