

Then it will be perfectly in order for the speaker to write these items out and even read them to his audience. The listeners will appreciate such brief items, and the speech will gain authenticity. understood by everyone. A good outline has a beginning, middle, and an end. This may sound basic but it is a phase of public speaking which requires a good deal of conscious attention. The body will consist of the main points which the speaker develops. In using the outline, the speaker should try and stay one step ahead of himself. As he finishes one point, he should take a quick glance at the outline so that his remarks will lead naturally to the next point. This makes for smoother transition and is especally necessary when one point is meant to complement another. Thus, a good speech. like a good




