The outline should cover the main points of your address, yet it should be brief. Otherwise, the speaker will become too interested in following his outline rather than in paying attention to his audience. The outline is the central line of argument, sketched very roughly. 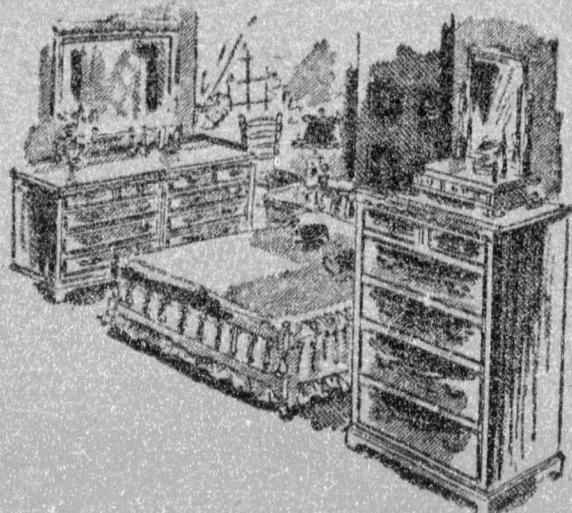

## National Urban League Appoints Thomas Acting Executive Director

NEW YORK, N. Y. — Julius A. Thomas, director of industrial relations for the National Urban League, has been named acting executive director in a statement made Sunday by Theodore W. Kheel, League president. Thomas will begin his new duties on November 18th when executive director Lester B. Granger leaves on a three-month mission to eastern and southern Asian countries and various parts of Africa.

Granger's trip will include his attendance as vice president of the International Conference of Social Work in Tokyo early in December. More than 350 Americans will meet with delegates from all over the world to discuss common social welfare problems from November 30th to December 6th.

Thomas will continue as industrial relations director but will drop many of his activities in that area to devote full time to the top direction of the national organization, said Mr. Kheel.

The veteran industrial relations chief has been with the Urban League movement more than 30 years, beginning as head of the League's Jacksonville, Florida, affiliate. Mr. Thomas came to New York in 1942 to take charge of the League's national industrial relations program. Under his leadership the organization has greatly expanded its cooperation with industrial and labor leadership — and today serves more than 300 of the leading multi-plant corporations in the United States.

He puts his best into his work — he awakens sleeping spirits, quickens the indolent, encourages the eager and steadies the unstable. He communicates his own joy in learning and shares with his students the best treasures of his mind. He lights many candles which in later years will shine back to cheer him, and this is his reward.

He pointed out that those who plan to go into the teaching profession should be of above average intellect with a good scholarship record as more and more society is asking for quality teachers who are prepared to motivate its citizens to high levels of achievement, who are deeply concerned about the needs and interests of students, who have a good and sound philosophy of life, who possess the talent for friendship.

outline will go into some detail, as, for example, when the speaker gives exact quotations or lists statistics and examples. Then it will be perfectly in order for the speaker to write these items out and read them to his audience. The listeners will appreciate such brief items, and the speaker will gain authenticity. Christ Himself spoke in parables so as to make His divine truth understood by everyone.

A good outline has a beginning, a middle and an end. This may sound basic but it is a phase of public speaking which requires a good deal of conscious attention. The body will consist of the main points which the speaker develops. In using the outline, the speaker should try and stay one step ahead of himself. As he finishes one point, he should take a quick glance at the outline so that his remarks will lead naturally to the next point. This makes for smoother transition and is especially necessary when one point is meant to complement another.

Thus, a good speech, like a good meal, begins long in advance of the finished product.

## CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

The North Carolina Department of Health announces an opening for a nutritionist II whose salary would range between \$5268 to \$6,444 per annum.

This person must be able to prepare and deliver effective talks before professional and other groups and to present materials through the use of various media. She must have ability to establish and maintain favorable working relationships with public health workers, school officials and teachers, welfare workers, community groups and various community agencies in the development and promotion of nutrition programs. Not only this, but she must be able to prepare guides for special therapeutic diets.

### Acceptable Experience and Training

The person must have four years of paid employment as a nutritionist in a public health or welfare agency, in agricultural extension services, or in private agencies carrying on a

nutrition and health program, of which one year must have been in a supervisory capacity and of which one year must have been under the supervision of a qualified nutritionist.

It is preferable that the person hold the M.A. degree with a major in nutrition or in foods and nutrition, including or supplemented by courses in public health or public health education and including a period of field training.
