# New Yorker Doubts City's Tolerance

NEW YORK — (ANP) — Robert J. Mangum, first deputy commissioner of hospitals, told an audience at the Building for Brotherhood meeting of the National Conference of Christians and Jews, "I find here in New York City, in such subtle ways, more hypocrisy on the subject of race and religion." Mangum was chairman of the meeting.

"Negroes," he related, "are still not welcome in some churches. There are jobs in this town a Negro or Jew can't hold. Very few Negroes are members of outstanding law firms, no matter how well they are qualified. City departments have supervisors full of bigotry and discrimination."

"Glaring examples of prejudice also exist in the Police Athletic League, GHI Scouts, Boy Scouts, and even among the adults in the organizations."

Commissioner Mangum concluded with the statement that many restaurants and other places admitted him only because of his
