Fear Of Tragic School Fires Closes Four Schools In City's Negro Areas

BOSTON — (AP) — Firemen, mindful of the tragic Chicago fire which snuffed out more than 300 innocent lives, have ordered closed four schools in the heart of the Negro area here in Boston.

The schools are the five-year-old Dought School, Albert School, Eben School and the Bennett. Spokesmen for the Boston Fire Department told reporters that the schools should be abandoned because of their ages and types of construction. Over 1,000 pupils will be affected by the closing of the schools. Temporary classrooms will have to be set up in nearby schools. For years Negro leaders in Boston have been advocating the rebuilding of the schools or the construction of new ones. But it took the tragic occurrence in Chicago to effect official action.

Dr. Smith Speaker At A & T College

GREENSBORO — An audience at A&T College was told last week that the spirit of Jesus must go alongside scientific development and progress if the world is to avoid self-destruction.

The speaker was Dr. James W. Smith, Sr., pastor of the Seventh Street Presbyterian Church at Charlotte, who delivered the sermon at the regular Chapel Service conducted in Harrison Auditorium.

Speaking from the subject, "Does Jesus Have Meaning for Life Today?" he said that while it is not difficult to understand the teachings of Jesus, it requires real effort to have these teachings become a part of our everyday living. "But," he continued, "too many of us today have little conception of these teachings and still too many care less about them."

He warned, "The world today is in need of brotherhood, that attitude which causes peoples of varying backgrounds, colors and races to have interest one for another." Dr. Smith was introduced by Rev. Cleo M. McCoy, director of religious activities.

The choir, under the direction of Howard T. Pearsall, chairman of the music department, sang two numbers, "Salvation is Created" by Tchaikoff and "Roll, Jordan, Roll," a traditional spiritual.

4-H Dairy Foods News For 1958

Four-Hers, their adult leaders, and the home economics agents for the N. C. Agricultural Extension Service, have paused to review their accomplishments in the dairy foods program for 1958.

Realizing that the major nutritional problem in this state is the low consumption of milk per person, effort has been highly concentrated to overcome this lack.

Miss Jo Earp, nutrition specialist for the N. C. Agricultural Extension Service, said statistics show a total of 79 counties had one or more programs on milk in every 4-H Club.

In addition to the 4-H Club meeting, Clay County reported a different 4-H team or individual gave a dairy foods demonstration in each of 12 Home Demonstration Club meetings.

Many counties from each part of the state reported requests for dairy foods demonstrations from civic and community clubs. Demonstrations of this kind totaled 1,029, reaching a total of 12,313 people.

Four-H adult leaders have become an important part of this vast program. With increased interest, these leaders have devoted their time and efforts to train and encourage the 4-H girls to give the dairy foods demonstrations. In Durham County, the home economics agents said, "Leaders took complete responsibility for training the girls for dairy foods demonstrations, securing judges, making arrangements, providing transportation and beginning and conducting the county dairy foods contests. As a result of the efforts of 17 adult leaders a total of 179 junior 4-H girls gave demonstrations."

From the conscientious efforts of the 4-H girls, their leaders and the home economics agents, there has been noted an increase in milk consumption in this state.
