The minister who led a successful bus boycot there two and a half years ago said a committee of the Montgomery Improvement Assn. is now working out the details of the integration attempt. He said the attempt will begin early next year, but added "nothing is work ed out in detail arrangement yet."

Rev. King confirmed, however, a broad outline of the integration plan. He said the initial step would be a series of conferences on the question with various white leaders in the cradle of the confederacy, He said the MIA, which he heads, would present a plan of desegregation to the Montgomery board of education in an attempt to work out a solution to the prob-


