Dr. Fosdick Given Phillip Murray Prize

NEW YORK—Dr. Harry Emerson Fosdick, pastor emeritus of Riverside Church, New York City, last night received the annual Phillip Murray Award of the NAACP Legal Defense and Educational Fund.

Dr. Fosdick is the third outstanding American to be honored by the Phillip Murray Award Committee for "contributing in great measure to the betterment of race relations in America. The award was made by Dr. Allan Knight Chalmers, president of the NAACP Legal Defense Fund, at a reception held at the home of Mrs. Chauncey Waddell, 1 Beekman Place, New York City. Mrs. Waddell is a Board member of the Fund. A check for \$1,000 accompanied the award which Dr. Fosdick will pass on to one of the many philanthropies in

which he is interested. The citation described Dr. Fosdick as one "who in the church and in the community has worked tirelessly for a society in which all men are truly brothers; who in a life crowded with duties has not only had the courage but always found time to act against injustice, no matter how powerful his antagonists; who, by the way in which he has lived his days, has helped countless men and women to accept and to strive for the attainment of his vision of a world of peace

Tan Korean Vet Appointed Chief Of Police In Palmyra, New Jersey

TRENTON, N. J. — (AP)—Payton L. Flourney, 36, a former Palmyra and Korean Marine Corps

veteran on Wednesday was appointed police chief of Palmyra, N. J., at a meeting of Palmyra Borough Council.

The first Negro to hold this office in Burlington County, Flourney had been acting police chief since the illness of Police Chief Joseph Rodgers last August.

Rodgers died last month, and since Flourney has been in office for the past four months, he has been credited with modernizing the department to keep it abreast with current police methods. An Identification Division has been established for fingerprinting suspected criminals and photographing crimes and accidents, along with a records division.

STRESSES PISTOL TRAINING
The ex-Marine has stressed pistol training for all regular and special officers and training in police procedure and working conditions.

According to Chief Flourney, he plans to further training methods in traffic problems, and in the use of Justice in which he is an expert.

Born in Palmyra 36 years ago, the ex-Marine was educated in his city, where he was track and football star.

Two years after Japan attacked the United States, he joined the Marine Corps and saw action both in the Pacific and Korea, and following his discharge he attended the New York University School of Education for two years.

Returning to his native city, Flourney joined the Palmyra Police Force on July 17, 1956, and was appointed a patrolman.

MADE SERGEANT IN 1957
Named a sergeant in March of 1954, the following year in September he became a first sergeant, and during his years on the force, he attended the State Police Man-
