### American Jewish Congress Hails Mayor Wagner For Leadership

NEW YORK — Mayor Wagner's role in helping make New York the "national leader in the fight against discrimination" was hailed by the American Jewish Congress Metropolitan Council this week in a surprise ceremony at Grace Mansion.

The Mayor and Mrs. Wagner were hosts at a reception honoring officers of the AJCongress metropolitan unit when Frank Abrams, a national vice-president of the organization, asked for quiet, approached the Mayor and read a citation praising his "courageous leadership in fighting bias and segregation in New York City."

The citation quoted a statement by the Rev. Theodore M. Hesburgh, who presided at hearings of the Federal Civil Rights Commission earlier in the week. Father Hes-

## William Hampton Haywood Represents State At Student Burgesses Meeting

WILLIAMSBURG, Va.—A 16-year-old Raleigh high school boy has been chosen to help represent North Carolina when the Williamsburg Student Burgesses convene here February 15 through 18. He is William Hampton Haywood of 714 East Martin Street, a student at J. W. Ligon Junior-Senior High School.

A unique and exciting educational event for young people sponsored by Colonial Williamsburg, the Student Burgesses will bring together outstanding high school students from coast to coast with their counterparts from 34 foreign countries to discuss "Individual Freedom: A Challenge to All Nations."

The American representation will consist of public, private and parochial high school students who are active in the 33

state chapters of the National Association of Student Councils, a department of the National Education Association.

The students from abroad are members of The New York Herald-Tribune Forum for High Schools, all between 16 and 18 years of age, selected in their own countries, in national competitions held under the auspices of their Ministries of Education.

Colonial Williamsburg, the sponsoring organization, is the non-profit educational corporation carrying forward the restoration of Williamsburg, Va., the 18th-century capital of the Virginia Colony. The organization was founded 32 years ago by John D. Rockefeller, Jr.

Also cooperating in the event will be the National Association of Student Councils, Scholastic Magazines, Inc., and the College of William and Mary.

The main purpose of the Wil-

liamsburg Student Burgesses, being held for the second successive year, will be to help prepare young people for their adult responsibilities as citizens of democratic nations. The program will emphasize better understanding of traditions, political institutions, and the demo-

cratic heritage. The historic atmosphere of restored 18th-century Williamsburg, source of many of America's democratic ideals, will be used to dramatize the continuity of public responsibility from the days when George Washington and Thomas Jefferson met here as Burgesses to the present time.

The program of the Williamsburg Student Burgesses will include discussion sessions, talks by international authorities, and historic tours.

Haywood, president of the North Carolina Association of Student Councils, is also a member of the National Honor Society, Radio Club, Model

Airplane Club, American Relay League, and his school's Student Council. He was the recipient of an American Legion Award in 1955, while in the 8th grade. His future plans are for a career in the field of aeronautical or electrical engineering.

North Carolina's other represen-

tative to the Williamsburg Student Burgesses will be William H. Weatherspoon of Durham High School, 15-year-old president of the Student Council Congress.
