**About Your Home**  
 By FRANCES DELL

It is not necessary to turn off your refrigerator when taking a short vacation. However, when planning to be away as long as two or three weeks, you should remove all the food, clean the box, turn the current off and leave the door ajar.

Take care not to overwork your refrigerator. If it is set for quick-freezing, be sure to turn the control back as soon as the job of freezing is completed. Each time the door is opened (this is very important to remember during the summer,) warm air rushes in, so open and close it only when necessary. Never let the door stand open.

If your refrigerator doesn't defrost automatically, it should be defrosted when the ice is about one-eighth inch thick. Too thick ice will slow down the cooling process and cause the motor to work much harder.

Never use a sharp instrument to remove ice trays. A broad spatula is helpful when removing stubborn ice trays.

Mild soap suds and a rinsing of soda and water is all that is necessary for washing the inside and the outside of a refrigerator. If a refrigerator is kept clean from the time it is new, there will be almost no spots which can't be removed.

Many of us have made a coal plant at one time. Perhaps some of you know it as cinder plant, cinder blossom or poor man's rose. No matter what you call it, this odd plant can be very attractive and an interesting bit of decoration in the home.

The coal plant is quite easy to make. Place a three or four-inch cinder in a shallow dish, scatter a tablespoon of salt on it, moisten with two tablespoons of liquid bluing and add just enough water to moisten the bottom of the dish.


