Take care not to overwork your refrigerator. If it is set for quick-freezing, be sure to turn the control back as soon as the job of freezing is completed. Each time the door is opened (this is very important to remember during the summer.) warm air rushes in, so open and close it only when necessary. Never let the door stand open.

If your refrigerator doesn't defrost automatically, it should be defrosted when the ice is about one-eighth inch thick. Too thick ice will slow down the cooling process and cause the motor to work much harder.

Never use a sharp instrument to remove ice trays. A broad spatula is helpful when removing stubborn ice travs.


