Sealed Bids will be received by Appalachian State Teachers College, Boone, North Carolina, in the Office of the President, until 2:00 P. M. o'clock on Thursday, April 15, 1954, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read for the furnishing of labor, material and equipment entering into the construction of a Swimming Pool Annex to the Physical Education Building for Appalachian State Teachers College, Boone, North Carolina. Separate bids will be received for the following categories of work:  
Contract No. 5 General Construction Work.  
Contract No. 6 Plumbing Work.  
Contract No. 7 Heating and Ventilating Work.  
Contract No. 8 Electrical Work.  
Contract No. 9 Filter and Recirculation Equipment Work.  
Sets of Contract Documents, including specifications and drawings, will be open for inspection in the office of the President, Appalachian State Teachers College, Boone, North Carolina, and in the office of J. N. Pease and Company, Engineers-Architects, 119-1-2 East Fifth Street, Charlotte, N. C., or sets may be obtained by those qualified and who will make bids upon a deposit of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) in cash or check for each category of work. The full deposit will be returned to those submitting bona fide proposals, provided the Contract Documents are returned to the Engineer-Architect in good condition within five (5) days after the date set for receiving bids.  
The building is a Class A Semi-fireproof Structure containing approximately 352,180 cubic feet. Framing is a combination of reinforced concrete and structural steel. Walls and partitions, generally, are brick and tile. Exterior finish is brick. Interior floor finishes include concrete, vinyl tile and ceramic tile. Interior wall finishes include plaster, structural facing tile, and ceramic tile. Ceilings are plaster or exposed structure. Steel windows and plastic sky domes are used. Door frames and labeled doors are steel. Other doors are flush, solid core wood.  
Contract No. 5 General Construction Work includes all work not covered by Contracts 6, 7, 8 and 9.  
Contract No. 6 Plumbing Work covers the installation of a complete drainage system and a complete hot and cold water system for the building, including the furnishing and complete installation of all plumbing and trim.

Contract No. 7 Heating and Ventilating Work covers the installation of a complete and fully operable heating and ventilating system, including all component parts.  
Contract No. 8 Electrical Work covers the installation of a complete and fully operable wiring system, including all fixtures, switchgear and other component parts.  
Contract No. 9 Filter and Recirculation Equipment Work covers the installation of a complete and fully operable water treatment and recirculation system for the Swimming Pool, together with all equipment, piping and accessories.  
All Contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the State laws governing their respective trades. General Contractors are notified that "An Act to Regulate the Practice of General Contracting", ratified by the General Assembly of North Carolina on March 10, 1928, and as subsequently amended (Public Laws of 1937 ratified March 23, Public Laws of 1949, ratified May 23) will be observed in receiving bids and awarding the General Contract.  
Plumbing and Heating Contractors are notified that Public Laws of 1931, Chapter 52, as amended by Public Laws of 1933, Chapter 57, will be observed in receiving bids and awarding Contracts.  
Electrical Contractors are notified that provisions of Chapter 37, Public Laws of 1937, ratified March 23, will be observed in receiving bids and awarding Contracts.  
Each bid shall be accompanied by a cash deposit or a certified check drawn on some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in an amount equal to not less than 5 per cent of the Base Bid. In lieu of making the cash deposit as above provided, the Bidder may file a Bid Bond executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bond, conditioned that the surety will upon demand forthwith make payment to the obligee upon said bond if the Bidder fails to execute the Contract in accordance with the Bid Bond and upon failure to forthwith make payment the surety shall pay to the Owner an amount equal to double the amount of said Bid Bond. This deposit shall be retained by the Owner if the successful Bidder fails to execute the Contract within ten (10) days after the award or to give satisfactory surety as required by law.
