airborne troops are combining conventional training with the Army's newest weapons in defensive and offensive operations as friendly forces fight to halt and destroy an "aggressor" army invading the U.S.

Farm Notes

The index of prices received by United States farmers declined two points, or eight-tenths of one cent, during the month ended March 15, 1954.

Total United States acreage planted to feed grains in 1954 will be above 1953 and the 1948-52 average if farmers carry out their March 1 intentions.

As of January 8, 1954, the Commodity Credit Corporation had outstanding loans on 5,739,512 bales of 1953-crop cotton.

The all farm products index of prices received by North Carolina farmers at local markets decreased two points (less than 1 per cent) during the month ended March 15, 1954.

The U. S. and Bonn Governments aid Berlin industry.

Indications point to a total United States corn planting of 81,037,000 acres, 0.4 per ent less than the 1953 acreage.

Prices received by North Carolina farmers increased less than

1 per cent during the month end-ed February 15.


