Rendleman To Have Mission

Rev. Toby A. Rendleman of Concord will conduct a preaching-teaching mission at Bethany Lutheran Church during the week of October 18-22. He will preach nightly during the week on some of the great themes of the Christian faith.
The preaching mission is a part of the outreach program of the Lutheran Church, according to the announcement made by the pastor, the Rev. George W. Shuford.
Rev. Mr. Rendleman's themes are, for Monday: "Seeking Those Things Above"; Tuesday: "The Other Fellow"; Wednesday: "And What Doth the Lord Require of You?"; Thursday: "Jesus and His Kingdom"; and Friday: "Around

the Cross." Each night's schedule includes a song session, the preaching service, and a period for questions from the congregation.
