The Public Health Service recently reported drops in the incience of poliomyelitis and hepatitis n 1956. The polio disease was from 29,270 cases in 1955 to 15,400 for 1956, a drop of about 47.5 per cent. Paralytic polio dropped from 10,641 cases to 6,708. Hepa titis inflamation of the liver) decreased from 31,340 cases to 19,-270. This disease has shown an upward trend, reaching a peak of about 50,000 cases in 1954. There was no apparent explanation of its last years' decline. Decreases were noted in cases of Diptheria while increases were noted for phalititis, typhoid fever and
