1956 BANKRUPTCIES There were 10,705 business failures in the first ten months of 1956, compared with 9,116 in the same period of 1955, according to a report by Dun & Bradstreet. Liabilities totaled about 30 per cent greater than in 1955. Business mortality was highest among the young establishments— one-fifth of the failing firms being only about a year old. About one-half of the bankruptcies were in retailing.
