Students who live in or near Banner Elk will be accepted as day students in this program.

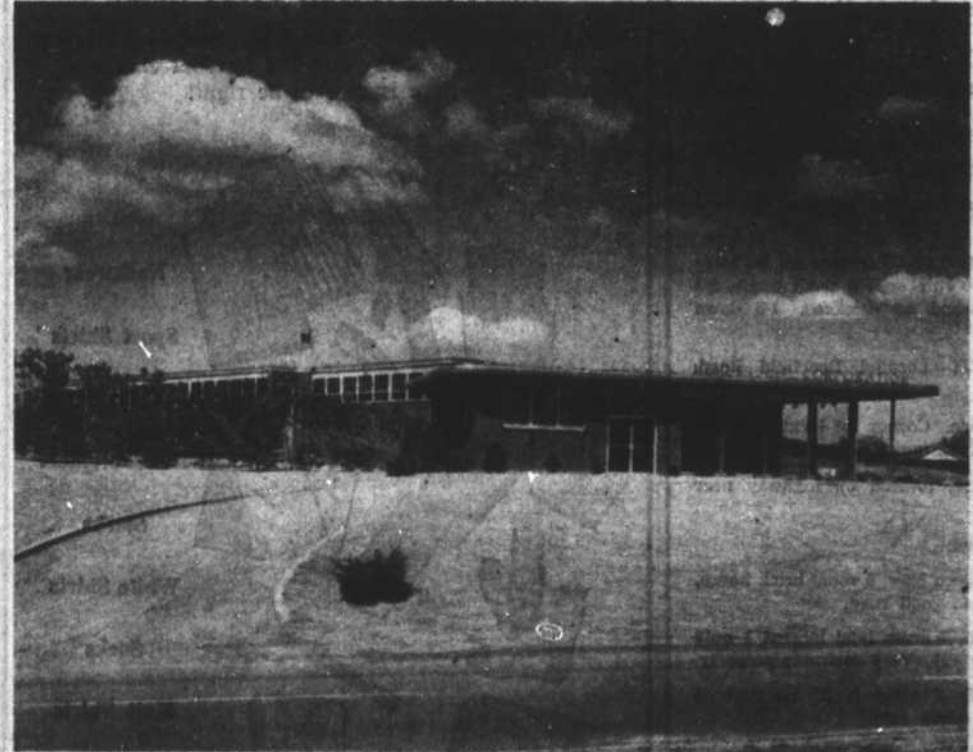
