Winchester To Aid Veterans

The North Carolina Veterans Commission will have Jack C. Winchester, district officer, in the County Service Office, Boone, on Friday, June 21, from 8:30 a. m. to 12 noon, to assist veterans and dependents.

Mr. Winchester states that all widows or children, or their guardians, receiving service connected death compensation from Veterans Administration, should inquire at once about changing to benefits under PL 881, 84th Congress—Dependency Indemnity and Compensation. For many of them it will mean increased benefits, and to get the full value of the increase effective January 1, 1957, application must be filed before the first of July this year. If an election is filed which is not the advantage of the claimant, Veterans Administration will so advise and take no further action unless requested.

All those dependents who have not already made the change should check immediately with Mr. Winchester or the nearest Veterans' Service Officer for further information and advice.

Rites Held For Clayton Price

Coy Clayton Price, 59, of Route 2, Boone, died June 5 at the Baptist Hospital in Winston-Salem. Funeral services were held June 7 at 2:00 p. m. at the Pleasant Grove Baptist Church. Rev. E. O. Gore preached the funeral. Burial was in the family cemetery.

Survivors were the widow, Julia Price of Tamarack; two sons, James of San Diego, California, and Charles of New Castle, Wyo.; two daughters, Mrs. William Reynolds and Ester Price of Caudersport, Penn.; three sisters, Mrs. Julia Pierce of Salem, North Dakota, Mrs. J. B. Pöbin of Brenin, North Dakota, and Mrs. Rebecca Nelson of New Castle, Wyo.
