Dry Weather Aids Applemen

This is one year that North Carolina apple growers will actually benefit by excessive dry weather—someone else's dry weather that is.

Donald E. Farris, marketing specialist for the N. C. Agricultural Extension Service, says that dry weather has hurt the apple crops north of this state. Apple crops in Virginia, West Virginia, Maryland and Pennsylvania have been reduced by about one third.

In addition, prolonged dry spells in these states have affected the size of the apples so much that some of them will not even be harvested.

Farris says that these conditions will improve North Carolina apple prices. Varieties hurt most by the dry weather are Grimes, Jonathan, York, Lowry, and Rome. Delicious and Stamen have sized up "surprisingly well," according to Farris.

He adds that the twice-as-large-as-normal apple crop in Washington State will result in a gradual weakening of the price of North Carolina Delicious apples, however.

WISCONSIN ELECTION

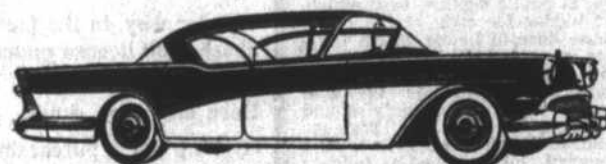

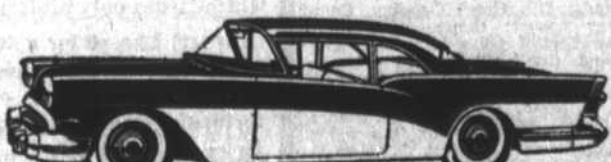
