

The hearing is scheduled to be held in the Recorders Courtroom, 2nd Floor, Town Hall, North Wilkesboro, North Carolina, beginning at 10:00 A. M., EST, Wednesday, January 30, 1963.

The streams to be considered during the hearing for reclassification are Yadkin River (W. Kerr Scott Reservoir including tributary streams below Elevation 1030) from Class "C" to Class "B" and Yadkin River from W. Kerr Scott Dam to Moravian Creek from Class "C" to Class "A-11". In addition, consideration will be given to adding the "trout waters" designation to the classifications assigned and proposed for Yadkin River and its tributaries from source to Reddies River, including Reddies River and its tributaries and W. Kerr Scott Reservoir below Elevation 1030 but excluding those streams entering the reservoir on the south side. These streams border on or flow through Caldwell, Wilkes, and Watauga Counties.
