

Selective Service Tests Are Set For April 18

Applications for the Selective Service College Qualification Test to be given on April 18 are now available to college students at the Selective Service local boards throughout North Carolina, according to Mr. Joe W. Todd, Chairman of Watauga County local board No. 96.

The test will be given at more than 500 colleges in all 50 states, Puerto Rico, and the Canal Zone. In North Carolina, the test will be offered at the following schools: Asheville-Biltmore, Asheville; Appalachian State Teachers College, Boone; Brevard College, Brevard; University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill; Davidson College, Davidson; Duke University, Durham; North Carolina College at Durham, Durham; Agricultural and Technical College of North Carolina, Greensboro; Guilford College, Greensboro; Lenoir Rhyne College, Hickory; North Carolina State College, Raleigh; Shaw University, Raleigh; Atlantic Christian College, Wilson; and Wake Forest College, Winston-Salem.

Scores made on the test will provide local boards with evidence of aptitude for continued undergraduate and graduate study. The scores will not of themselves determine eligibility for deferment, but are considered with other information by the boards in determining whether to defer individual registrants for study.

Applications for the test must be postmarked no later than midnight, Thursday, March 28. Students may obtain the application blanks and information about the test from any local board.

The test, used since 1951 to aid local boards in determining questions of student deferment, is administered by Science Research Associates, McHenry, Ill.

To be eligible to take the test, the applicant must be satisfactorily pursuing a full-time college course, undergraduate or graduate, leading to a degree. The applicant must be a Selective Service registrant who intends to seek deferment as a student. He can take the test only once.

Mr. Todd pointed out that a test in the registrant's file will give the local board an additional piece of important information to use in determining if
