### Doctor Talk

Diabetes, more specifically diabetes mellitus, is a condition affecting the body when the inability to convert sugars and starches into the energy needed for normal activity arises. It is a condition, which prior to the development of insulin in 1922, was almost invariably fatal. Today, thanks to modern medical science, the well-controlled diabetic can expect to live out a virtually normal lifetime.

The exact cause of diabetes is not known, but from prolonged and exhaustive studies, it is known that in order for the body to metabolize or break down carbohydrates, insulin is necessary. The insulin required by the body is classed as a hormone and is manufactured by the pancreas. For a diabetic condition to arise, several conditions, singularly or in combination, may exist—the pancreas gland may not produce any insulin, or it may produce this hormone in insufficient quantities; or the gland may produce enough insulin, but for some reason the release of insulin into the circulatory blood is inadequate for the body needs; or the proper amount of insulin may be produced but some other chemical in the body may destroy or interfere with the insulin released; in any event the symptoms of diabetes develops.

This "error of metabolism" is a universal disease, affecting persons of all ages. Statistics show that susceptibility to diabetes does increase with age. The incidence of onset is great in men by their fifty-first year, and in women by the fifty-fifth year. Disregarding all jokes to the contrary, married men statistically, in this incidence at least, have the edge over unmarried men, the incidence being higher in the latter. The opposite is true in women, unmarried women appearing to be less susceptible than married women.
