

Woodcock Named ASTC Instructor

Eidon G. Woodcock of Durham will join the Appalachian State Teachers College faculty on September 1, 1963, as instructor in religion, according to announcement by Dr. W. H. Flemmons, president of ASTC.

The new faculty member is a graduate of Swarthmore College and Dallas Theological Seminary. Currently he is working toward the Ph.D. degree at Duke University.

Announcing Woodcock's appointment, Dr. Flemmons said, "We are delighted to have Mr. Woodcock join our faculty as instructor in religion. We welcome him and his family to our college community and to our town."

The Washington, D. C., native is a member of the Society of Biblical Literature and the National Association of Biblical Instructors. He is married and is a member of the Methodist Church.

Williams To Go To Berea

Dr. Cratis Williams, director of graduate studies at Appalachian State Teachers College, will participate in a workshop on "Urban Adjustment of Southern Appalachian Migrants" at Berea College in Kentucky this week.

The college professor will serve as consultant for the workshop and will lead the discussion on the "Culture and History of Southern Appalachian Mountain People." Dr. Williams will also have charge of the Thursday morning program.

This is the fifth annual workshop concerning the problems of Southern Appalachian Migrants, and this is the third time that Dr. Williams has been asked to serve on the workshop faculty.

He said that the purpose of the workshop is to assist migrant children in making adjustments in northern cities.

Those attending the workshop include educators and law enforcement officials.

Know The Weather

Do the winds of a hurricane in the southern hemisphere rotate around the eye clockwise or counter-clockwise?

In the southern hemisphere winds around such storms rotate clockwise — just the opposite from their movement in the northern hemisphere. This is believed to be caused by the motion of the turning earth.

All the signs and warning omens of hurricanes, then, would be read differently in the southern hemisphere. Many other phenomena are different below the equator.

Nature's deflection of bullets and shells, growing characteristics of certain trees, the way rivers cut into one bank, are all different in the southern hemisphere. There the prevailing veer of these things is to the left, not the right.
