

Apps Blank Eagles In Homecoming Tilt

The Appalachian Mountaineers celebrated Homecoming last Saturday afternoon by defeating the Eagles of Carson-Newman College 24-0 before approximately 5,000 students and old grads. Appalachian held a 7-0 lead throughout most of the game but exploded for 17 points mid-way the last quarter to turn a close defensive battle into a rout.

Appalachian reached paydirt midway the second quarter when fullback Larry Lawing ran over tackle for five yards and a score, climaxing a 45-yard drive. The Mountaineers had previously driven over for a touchdown on a drive, only to lose the ball and the score when Jimmy Hayes fumbled in the end zone. Saunders added the extra point with a kick.

Early in the third quarter end Joe Hightower added insurance to the Mountaineer cause when he booted a 28-yard field goal for a 10-0 lead. The score was set up when the Mountaineers drove from their own 16 to the Eagle 11 but were held for downs.

Five minutes and one threat later the Apps hit pay dirt again when linebacker Greg Van Orden intercepted a Carson-Newman pass on the Eagle 20 and ran it over for a touch-
