HAM SLAW
2 to 3 cups diced, cooked ham
3 c. coarsely shredded cabbage
1 carrot, thinly sliced
1/4 c. chopped green pepper
2 eggs
2 T. sugar
1/2 t. salt
1/4 t. pepper
1/3 c. vinegar
1/3 c. water
Cabbage or lettuce leaves
Beat eggs. Add sugar, salt, pepper, vinegar and water. Cook over low heat and stir constantly until mixture thickens slightly—about 2 to 3 minutes. Chill.
Combine ham, cabbage, carrot, green pepper and onion. Add chilled dressing and toss lightly. Serve in lettuce or cabbage lined salad bowl.
