Midnight High Mass At St. Ann's Church

In solemn and joyful celebration of the anniversary of the Incarnation of Jesus Christ, the Son of God and founder of the Catholic Church, the Most Holy Sacrifice of the Mass will be offered three times Christmas: First at Midnight (between Christmas Eve and Christmas Day) in St. Ann's Church, corner of N. Broad and Albemarle Streets, Edenton; the second at 8:45 a. m., at Harvey Point Air Station; the third at Windsor Prisoners of War Labor Camp at 4:30 p. m., stated the Reverend Father Francis J. McCourt, Pastor and Chaplain. Everybody invited to St. Ann's.

The first and third Masses will be Missa Cantata de Angelis (Sung Mass of the Angels) in centuries old Gregorian chant accompanied by music, with traditional Christmas hymns, Holy Communion at all the services, each preceded by confessions, with sermon during Masses of "Christ's Mass, or It's the Mass That Matters."

A remarkably faithful miniature reproduction in figures of the first Christmas will be on display in St. Ann's from Midnight Mass to January 13.

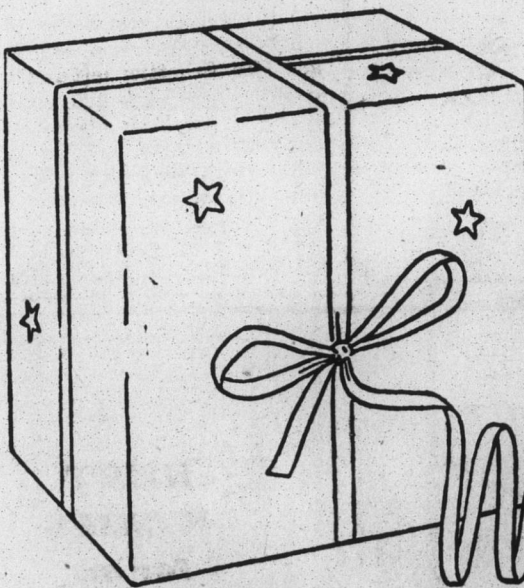
