McKee and Mrs. Wade Robinson, both of Clarkton; and five brothers, Luther Hill of Bladenboro, Dennis Hill of Clinton, William Hill of Council, Emery Hill of Abbotsburg and James C. Hill of Clarkton. A son, Glenn Hill, and a daughter, Mrs. Howard Cook of Bladenboro, by an earlier marriage also survive.
