

County's Property Valuation Boosted For Year 1946-47

Tax Supervisor McMullan Reports Increase Of \$28,230

According to Tax Supervisor P. S. McMullan, Chowan County will have a county tax levy valuation of \$8,564,871 for 1946-47. This figure represents a gain over the previous year of \$28,230, when the valuation was \$8,536,641.

In Mr. McMullan's report it is interesting to note that there are 1,269 town lots listed, which is 42 above the 1945 figure. There are 925 dogs listed, which is 51 over the previous year, and 1,600 motor vehicles, 54 more than in 1945-46.
