Ernest White left last week to enter the veterans' hospital at Keogh, where he was operated on Monday. Last reports were to the effect that he was making satisfactory progress.

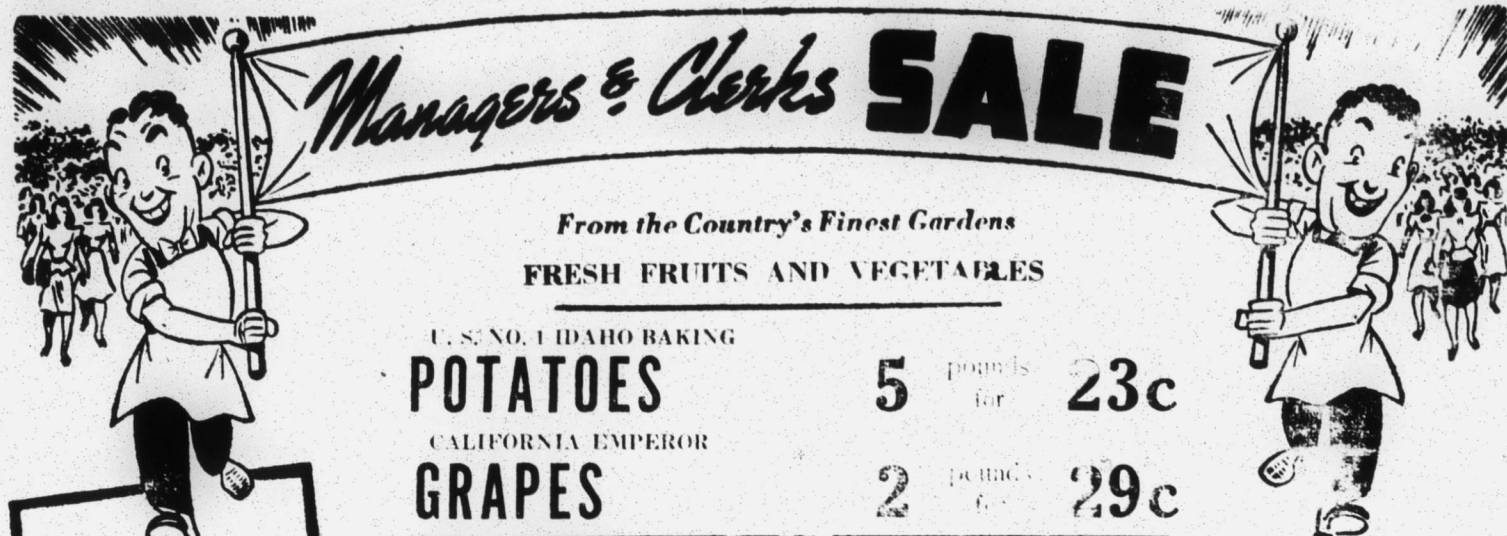
REVENUE FROM BEER SOARS
