Richard Plant Dies After Falling Into Tub Of Hot Water

On Tuesday night, November 19, death claimed the little body of Richard Edward Plant, age 2 years, 11 months and 6 days.

Tuesday morning young Richard experienced severe burns on the lower part of his body from accidentally falling backward into a tub of hot water. He was immediately rushed to Albemarle Hospital, Elizabeth City. All was done for him that loving hands could do, but God saw best to transplant the little bud of life into the beautiful flower garden of heaven, there to bloom in purity forever.

None save those who have experienced the sad loss fully realize the bereavement of the fond mother and grandparents, but 'tis a blessed thought to know that Dickey is now enjoying the blessings of his celestial home, where he awaits the coming of relatives and loved ones to join him.

Funeral services were conducted at the home on Thursday afternoon, November 21, at 3 o'clock by the Rev.


