

Negro Club Women Make County Tour

Affair Climax to Celebration of Home Demonstration Week

On Thursday morning of last week at 10 o'clock, 52 club women and eight men left the home agent's office to see the improvements made by Home Demonstration Club women in Chowan County.

The following communities were included in the tour:

St. John—Mrs. Olivia Wiggins: Library and sewing room. The room was painted, rug placed on floor and curtains made from cheese cloth.

Canaan Temple—Mrs. Laretta Coston: Front yard, shrubs were planted around the front porch to serve as screen until it can be underpinned; grass was sown in the yard.

Canaan Temple—Mrs. Lula Wills: Flowers. Beautiful flowers of all kinds were seen.

Edenton—Mrs. Sadie Fayton: Kitchen and bath room. The old kitchen was turned around, cabinets built, new doors and windows cut and painted. A new room was added over the kitchen for the bath room. The bath room has all modern equipment.

Virginia Fork—Mrs. Geneva Boyce: Home. The family bought wooded land, cleared and built the house.

Warren Grove—Mrs. Clara Carter: Out door living room. Chairs, tables and magazine racks were made and painted and placed out doors under a tree on the lawn for the summer.

Warren Grove—Mrs. Elton Hall: Kitchen. Part of the back porch was taken for the kitchen, the room was painted, running water added, sink made from an old oil stove; gas stove used for cooking; refrigerator.

Green Hall—Mrs. Lula Welch: Kitchen: The floor has been tiled and walls tiled half way up. The other part painted and cabinets added.

Green Hall—Mrs. Elenora Roberts: Kitchen. Lights and electric stove added.

Center Hill—Mrs. Charity Twine: Kitchen and brooder house. The kitchen was painted; cabinets added, sink and running water; electric stove. Brooder house with oil burner.

Hudson Grove—Mrs. Lillian H. Parks: Backyard. A back porch added; flowers and grass planted.

Hudson Grove—Mrs. Annie Morris: A new kitchen was built with cabinets started.

The last place was the Hudson Grove Community Center, which was built by different organizations in that community.

Vets' Question Box

Q.—Will VA pay my bill if I go to a private hospital in my home town instead of a VA hospital in a distant city?

A.—Yes, but only for a service-connected disability and if you have secured prior approval from VA.

Q.—My brother plans to go to school this summer for the first time under the GI Bill. I am already attending a school under the same bill. I wish to attend the same school my brother attends this summer. Do we have to make application in advance to attend summer school?

A.—Yes. Your brother should apply now for a VA certificate of eligibility; and, if you intend to continue your education this summer in a different school, you should apply as soon as possible for a supplemental certificate of eligibility.

Q.—I am a disabled veteran and would like to know on what basis compensation for service connected disability is granted?

A.—The disability must result from disease or injury incurred in or

aggravated by active military or naval service in line of duty.

Q.—What interest rates are lenders permitted to charge on business loans?

A.—In most cases, 4 per cent is the maximum. However, the interest rate may be slightly higher for certain types of insured business loans.

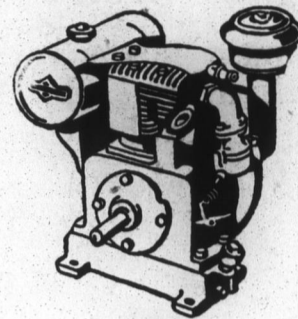

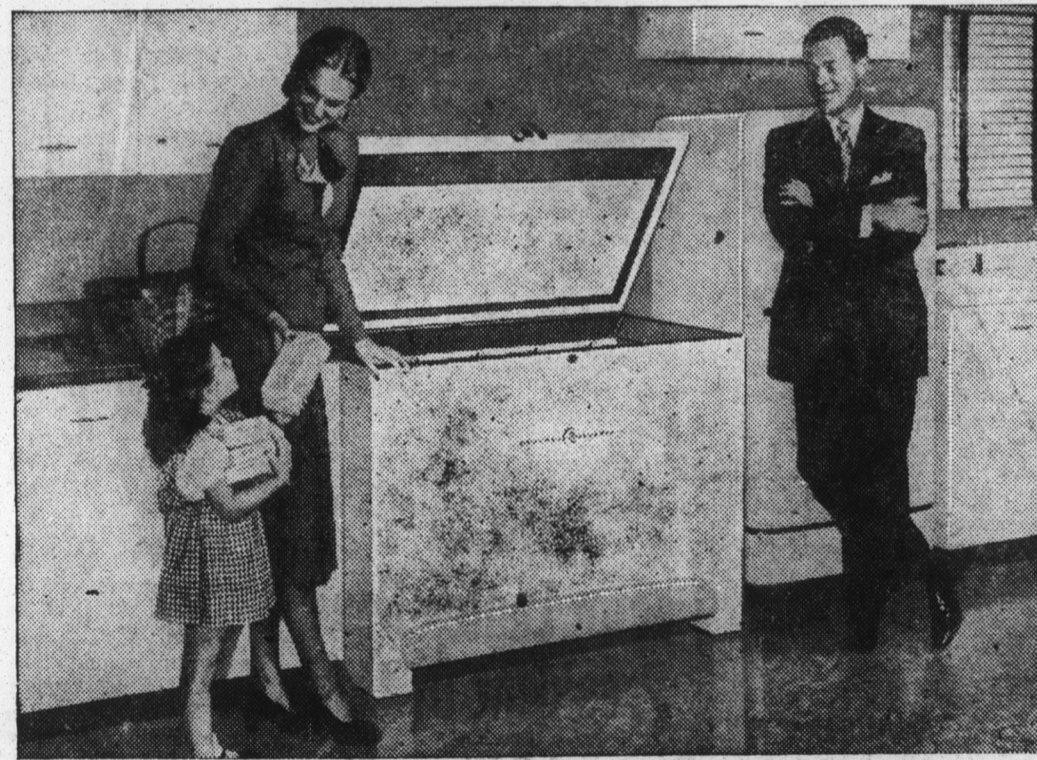
