R. C. Jordan and George A. Conner, Jr., of the Soil Conservation Service, assisted the Francis' with the tile installation. Their help in this instance consisted of making the necessary surveys, setting of batter boards for grade and supervision of the tile laying and backfilling.

Louis Francis will put in about 800 feet of this tile on his home farm soon. Here he expects to drain another bottom area.

Recently complete conservation farm plans were set up for Preston Monds, A. L. Boyce, Lloyd G. White, Sidney White and Noah Goodwin, Sr. These men will be assisted by the Albemarle Soil Conservation District in making the various conservation improvements to their farms, as listed in the farm plans.

Paul Ober set out 300 Multiflora rose seedlings about the first of March. Practically all of the seedlings are living even though put out in loamy fine sand. The planting was made in one straight row and will be used as 300 feet of fence-"living ence." The Multiflora rose seedlings were supplied Mr. Ober by the N. C. Wildlife Resources Commission in cooperation with the Albemarle Soil Conservation District.

According to Warren W. Currier, biologist of the Wildlife Commission Mr. Ober is the first farmer in North Carolina to use Multiflora rose as a

Japanese beetles have become such Carolina that farmers and other property owners in these areas are warned to exercise their own control measures instead of relying on public agencies to check the invaders' depredations.

C. H. Brannon, head of the Entomology Division of the State Department of Agriculture, said that infestations have become so widespread that the joint state-federal control program is insufficient to cope with the problem.

"Those engaged in this program," he continued, "will have to concentrate this year on reducing infestation at loading points and preventing spread of the insects to new areas.
