

Dr. Wallace Griffin Is Named Chairman Of Blood Program

Collection of Blood Expected to Start in Fall

Geddes Potter, chairman of the Chowan County Red Cross Chapter, has announced the appointment of Dr. Wallace S. Griffin as chairman of the Chowan County Blood Program. Dr. Griffin in turn has appointed nine committee chairmen to serve with him and include the following:

Dr. Griffin and his committee recently met with Miss Margaret Margrave, blood program representative of the American Red Cross, when she explained the blood program and its advantages to Chowan County, and congratulated Dr. Griffin on the progress already made.

The Blood Program in Chowan County will get underway in the fall after the Tidewater Blood Center of the American Red Cross, in Norfolk, Va., officially opens.

Three times a year the mobile unit from the Tidewater Center will visit Chowan County to receive donations of blood from local residents and within 72 hours after the first visit of the mobile to this community a supply of blood will be received in the local hospital, which will be free of charge to patients who need it.

This program, Dr. Griffin announced, has received the full endorsement of the Chowan County health authorities, and he feels sure he and his committee will receive full cooperation from the entire community for such a worthy program.

but returned to Tyner to take over his father's church field completing his B. A. This was no small challenge for a young minister of 22, for the three churches of nearly 2,000 members composed what is believed to be the largest rural church field in the world. Recently the field was divided with Rocky Hock going full time and the Rev. Mr. Lemons called as pastor of the Center Hill and Warwick churches.

Mr. Cale's success was well marked, for he continued as pastor for 12 fruitful years until 1944, when he resigned to go to Southern Seminary at Louisville. This completed a ministry of 29 years for father and son at the three churches.

Mr. Cale has been pastor of the Culppeper Baptist Church of Culppeper, Virginia, since 1947, when he graduated from the seminary.
