### **Veterans Eligible For Pensions**

Disability Need Not Result From Military Service

Veterans of World War I or II who have become unable to follow a gainful occupation because of disability may be entitled to receive a pension even though the disability did not result from military service.

Rules and regulations governing pensions payable for non-service connected disabilities have been liberalized which affords older veterans an opportunity to qualify for total disability benefits even though the degree of disability may not be total. Many veterans who have been denied total disability benefits in the past may be eligible to apply again.

A veteran must have been discharged under conditions other than dishonorable after serving a minimum of 90 days service, or unless discharged sooner for line of duty disa-


