

First Round Won To Help Improve Fishing

Three Bills Combined Into One and Reported Favorably

Three Congressmen have won the first round in their fight to aid the diminishing game and commercial fishing industry along the Atlantic coast.

The House Merchant Marine and Fisheries Committee on Thursday combined into one and reported favorably in three bills designed to authorize:

- 1—A study of shad and herring in Pamlico and Albemarle Sounds, N. C.
- 2—A study of the shortage of croakers in the Chesapeake Bay.
- 3—A study of the decline in game fish all along the Atlantic coast with particular emphasis placed on declines in Delaware Bay and along the New Jersey Coast.

The three bills were introduced separately by Congressman Herbert C. Bonner of North Carolina; the late S. G. Bland of Virginia, and Representative C. A. Herter of Massachusetts.

The one-package bill now goes to the House for further action.

Should the bill pass, the combined studies will be undertaken by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service for a period not to exceed five years.

Using data based on its investigations, the Wildlife Service will then make recommendations to the states as to measures which should be employed to increase the abundance of the fish.

180 Benefit By Old Age Assistance In June

During the month of June, 180 persons in Chowan County received old age assistance with \$4,574 being distributed for this purpose. During the month, \$1,312 was distributed among 31 aid to dependent children cases and \$498 to 17 aid to blind cases.

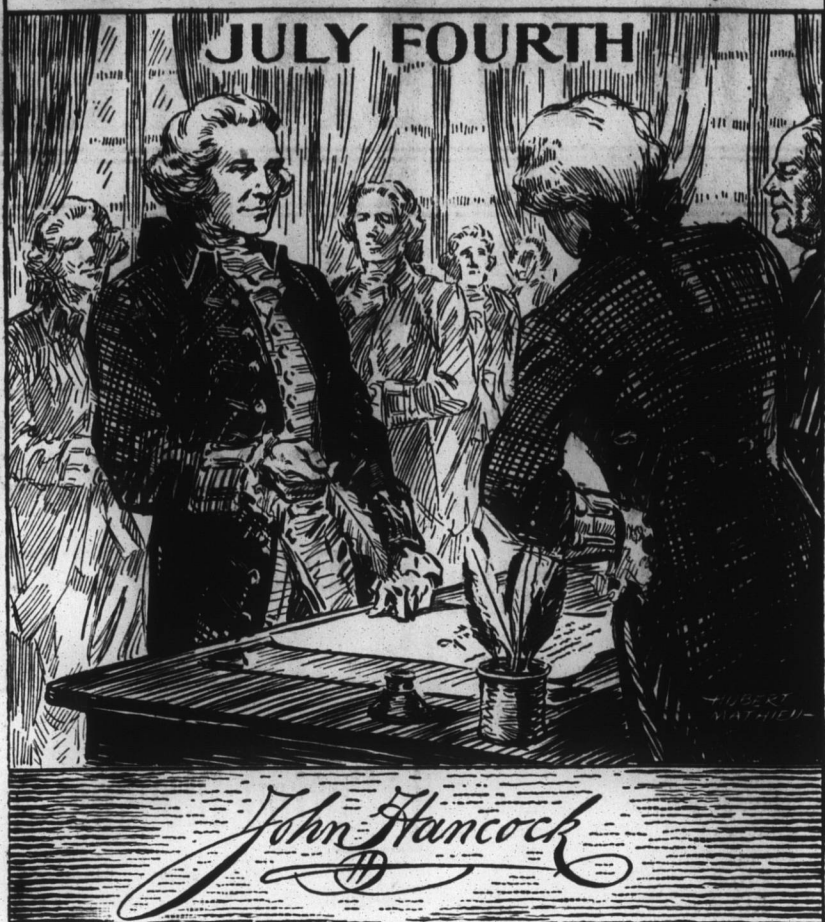
There were six general assistance cases receiving \$160, and other financial assistance included three persons hospitalized in the county, four hospitalized outside the county, medicine for one person and one pauper funeral.

Service cases included 11 child labor certificates issued, four persons receiving veterans rehabilitation in cooperation with the Welfare Department, six children referred to the N. C. Commission for the Blind for eye examinations, one adult parolee under supervision and 28 children receiving individual service.

County Agent C. W. Overman. Five per cent DDT dust impregnated with mineral oil is being used at the rate of 25 to 30 pounds per acre per application. On three plots where the first application was made at the time silking began and subsequent applications at three day intervals were made the corn appears to be practically clean of ear worms. On two plots where the first application was made when around 20 to 25 per cent of the

silks have emerged there is some ear worm damage. The check plots left undusted are showing some ear worm damage and one field rather high. The results of this work will be determined by definite checks at harvest time.

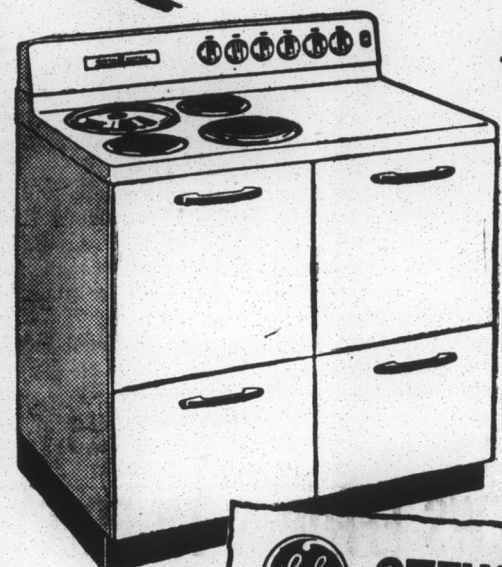

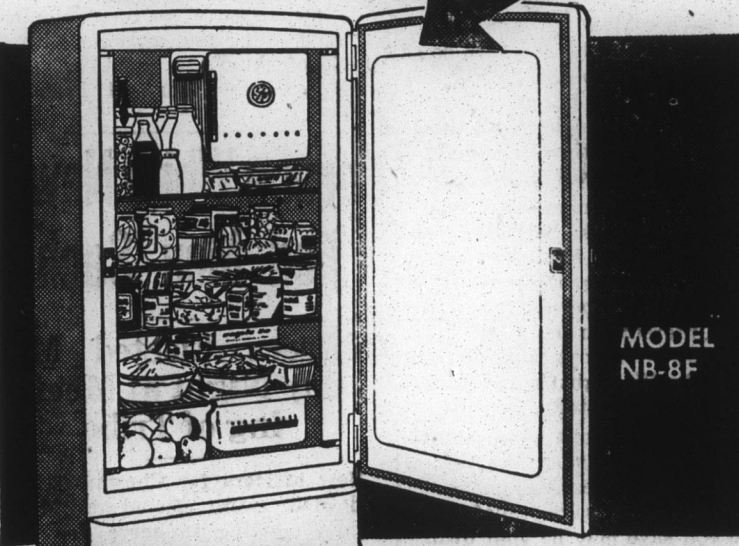
