

Speeders In State Face Court Action

3,851 Are Convicted For Speeding During First Month Of Year

Nearly 4,000 North Carolina motorists faced court action for speeding last month, the Department of Motor Vehicles reports. In its first monthly summary of traffic violations for the new year the Department reported 3,851 speeding convictions; 2,206 convictions for reckless driving and 1,538 for driving without an operator's permit.

For failing to stop for a stop sign or red light 644 motorists were convicted; 305 answered charges for driving with improper lights; 228 were caught and convicted for passing on hills and curves; and 112 were convicted for failing to give a hand signal.

Failing to give right-of-way brought 104 convictions. Miscellaneous violations carried the month's total to 10,211.

Out of state drivers accounted for another 1,335 convictions, bringing the grand total to 11,566 persons found guilty of traffic violations on the streets and highways of the state during January.

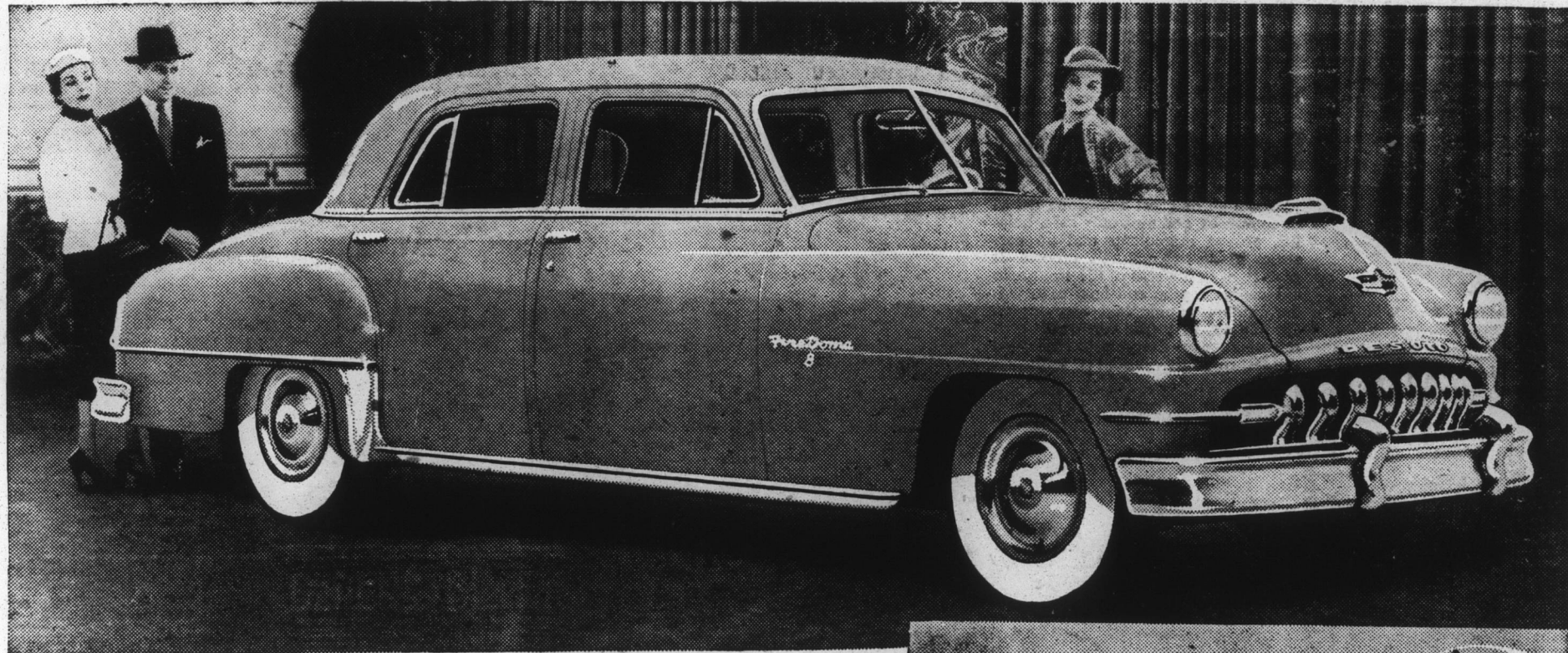
