

Products following sheets as cotton consumers were shirts, automobiles, men's trousers and drapery-upholstery-slipover fabrics. These five top customers accounted for almost a fourth of the estimated cotton consumption.

Sheets consumed 523,000 bales of cotton in 1952. Cotton used in men's shirts increased last year, accounting for a total of 475,000 bales.


Automobiles required 460,480 bales during the year. The use of cotton in men's trousers jumped.11 per cent in 1952 over the preceding year. Total cotton consumed in men's trousers reached 449,930 bales.

# **Chowan Than In Sev**eral Years

Bud worms in tobacco are worse than they have been in several years, according to Assistant County Agent Robert S. Marsh, and many farmers have consulted the county agent's office concerning their control.

Many farmers have mixed arsenic with land plaster before applying to the tobacco plants. In most cases this mixture has given good results. However, it has not proved satisfactory this year. If the arsenic is mixed at the rate of one pound to 75 pounds of corn meal and a pinch is added to each bud it should control the bud worm. It is very important to mix the poison and the meal thoroughly before using. If a farmer prefers to use a dust, then he can use 5 per cent DDT or 10 per cent TDE. 


