Ancient and Modern Damascus



OLDEST AND NEWEST METROPOLIS: Damascus, capital of Syria, one of the Bible Lands, is reputed to be the oldest continuously inhabited city in the world but in some respects it is among the most modern. The resident section, portrayed above, is criss-crossed by broad boulevards, public parks, flowering gardens and gleaming new apartment houses. Not far from this scene is the American Embassy. The city is being re-constructed along modern lines but its ancient treasures are being preserved. Among the sights of the older section are the Biblical Street called Straight, the House of Ananias and St. Paul's Wall. It was on the road to Damascus that Paul saw a blinding light (Acts 9, 3) and was converted to Christianity.
