Higher Insurance In Seacoast Area

Chowan County is included in the seacoast area affected by an insurance ruling handed down last Friday by Charles F. Gold, Insurance Commissioner, which permits new higher rates and bigger exemptions on windstorm coverage within the area.

Local insurance agencies, as yet, are not aware of the complete effect the ruling will have on insurance coverage in this county but they expect further information within a short time

Counties affected by the new ruling include those designated as seacoast territory and are Beaufort, Brunswick, Camden, Carteret, Chowan, Craven, Currituck, Dare, Hyde, Jones, New Hanover, Ons ow, Pamlico, Pasquotank, Pender, Perquimans, Tyrrell and Washington.




