

Answer: These are questions scientists are not prepared to answer at the present time. A large number of studies are under way to obtain information on forest tree fertilization. It may be 10 years, however, before any conclusive results are obtained. The scientists must first figure out the mineral requirements of each tree species, and then decide if the application of these minerals will be economical.

Question: Does it pay to clip the udder and flanks of a milk cow?

Answer: Yes, say dairy specialists for the N. C. Agricultural Extension Service. The clipping saves time in milking, as well as time in cleaning the udder before milking. This is especially true during cold weather when the hair is long.
