will have sailed into most of the major ports of the world flying the flag of the United States, and demonstrating to all people that our Nation wishes to use nuclear power for peaceful purposes. I want to be one of the first to pay my respects to the man most responsible for the nuclear ship SAVANNAH.

Chairman Bonner stated that he deeply appreciated Congressman Tolleson's remarks. He felt that it was particularly important in that it will go far to put the record straight that construction of the NS SAVANNAH as a practical nuclear-powered cargo-passenger ship had its origin in the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries in the House.

Mr. Bonner said, "This great step forward in our merchant marine was due to the collective effort of all of the members of the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries and the sup-

port received from members of the Congress in both Houses."
