Memory Selection: "There is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus." (1 Timothy 2:5)

Lesson Text: 1 Timothy.

Today's lesson is the first in a ten-session unit on "The Character of Christian Faith." The purpose of this unit is to help adults understand several of the important characteristics of a mature Christian faith.

Our lesson begins with a testimony. Paul was grateful to God for his appointment as an evangelist of the gospel of Christ. He thought of his earlier life as being a blasphemy.

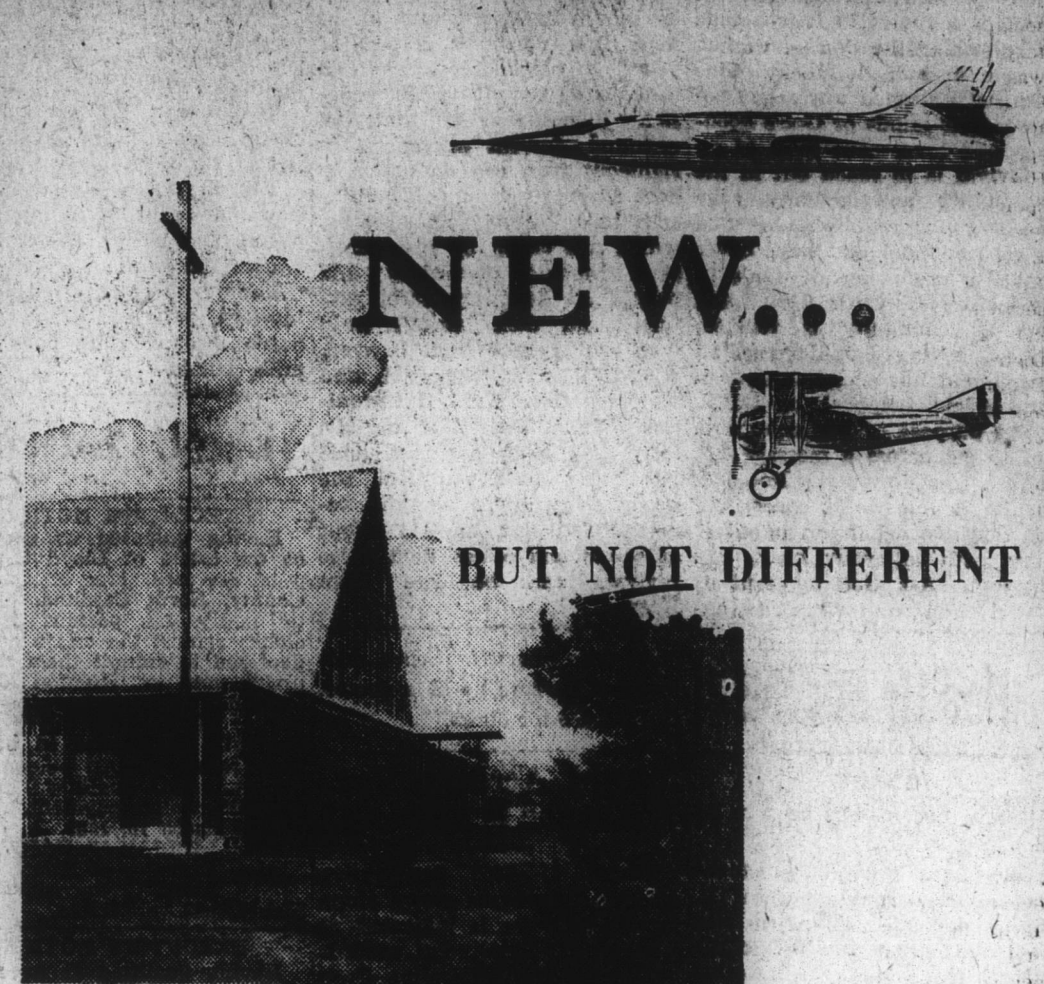
ter, however, when he realized that he had acted ignorantly, God graciously lifted him from the pit of ignorance and commissioned him to preach to the Gentiles. As the "foremost of sinners" Paul considered himself an example of what God can do for even the vilest of His creatures.

In the second Christian century certain theologians and teachers, disciples of a man named Marcion, said that there were two gods. The more inferior—the god of the Old Testament—was the creator of the world. But another God—the true and higher one—was revealed for the first time in Jesus.

Other teachers, called Gnostics, believe that between the highest God and human beings were many mediators. Both
