Grass Waterways
SCS technicians helped J. B. Hollowell, in the Cross Roads Community, to construct three grass waterways on one of his fields last week. These waterways were planned in Mr. Hollowell's basic conservation farm plan in 1959. Before the waterways could be constructed an open ditch had to be constructed as an outlet. After the spoil for the open ditch was spread last week the waterways were shaped with the bulldozer that was spreading the spoil. The waterways were then disked, limed, fertilized and seeded to fescue. Surface inlets to drop the water safely into the outlet ditch were installed where each waterway entered the outlet ditch. A ten foot strip of fescue was seeded along side the outlet ditch to prevent erosion of the side slopes of the ditch.

Hairy Indigo
Hairy indigo was tried as a summer cover crop by four farmers in Chowan County last year. This legume appears to do

a good job on sandy land and may be a solution to the summer cover crop problem on light land. Hairy indigo is an annual, root knot, nematode resistant legume which is non-toxic to animals. It can be seeded at 10 lbs. per acre for approximately \$3.00.

Farmers who seeded hairy indigo last summer were Paul Ober, Luther Bunch, H. F. Byrum and B. F. Bateman.

Pollock Swamp Watershed
The design survey that is being made on Pollock Swamp will be completed in the next few days. Location stakes for the channel were set in the centerline of all of the proposed channels.

Elevations and other necessary information will be obtained. This information was needed for a complete and final design so that we could prepare a contract for the job. As soon as the local legal organization is completed and they get up their money, we will be ready to start construction work.
