Magazine Reports School Progress Many Subjects Being Taught Earlier In Grades

Public demand for better schools, along with the rise in college admission standards and the scientific achievements of the Soviet Union, has produced marked improvement and development in education, according to Changing Times, the Kiplinger Magazine.

Citing a recent survey of 1,500 elementary and secondary school principals, an article in the current issue of the magazine states that in the last five years schools have begun placing a stronger emphasis on basic subjects—science, math and foreign languages—and, in elementary schools, on the fundamentals—reading, writing, spelling and arithmetic.

In addition, the article notes, many subjects are being taught earlier, with elementary grades receiving science, social studies and even some algebra, and high school subjects are being moved to junior high.

As for the students, the survey found most principals in agreement that the work demanded of pupils has increased and that there will be a growing pressure for still more work.

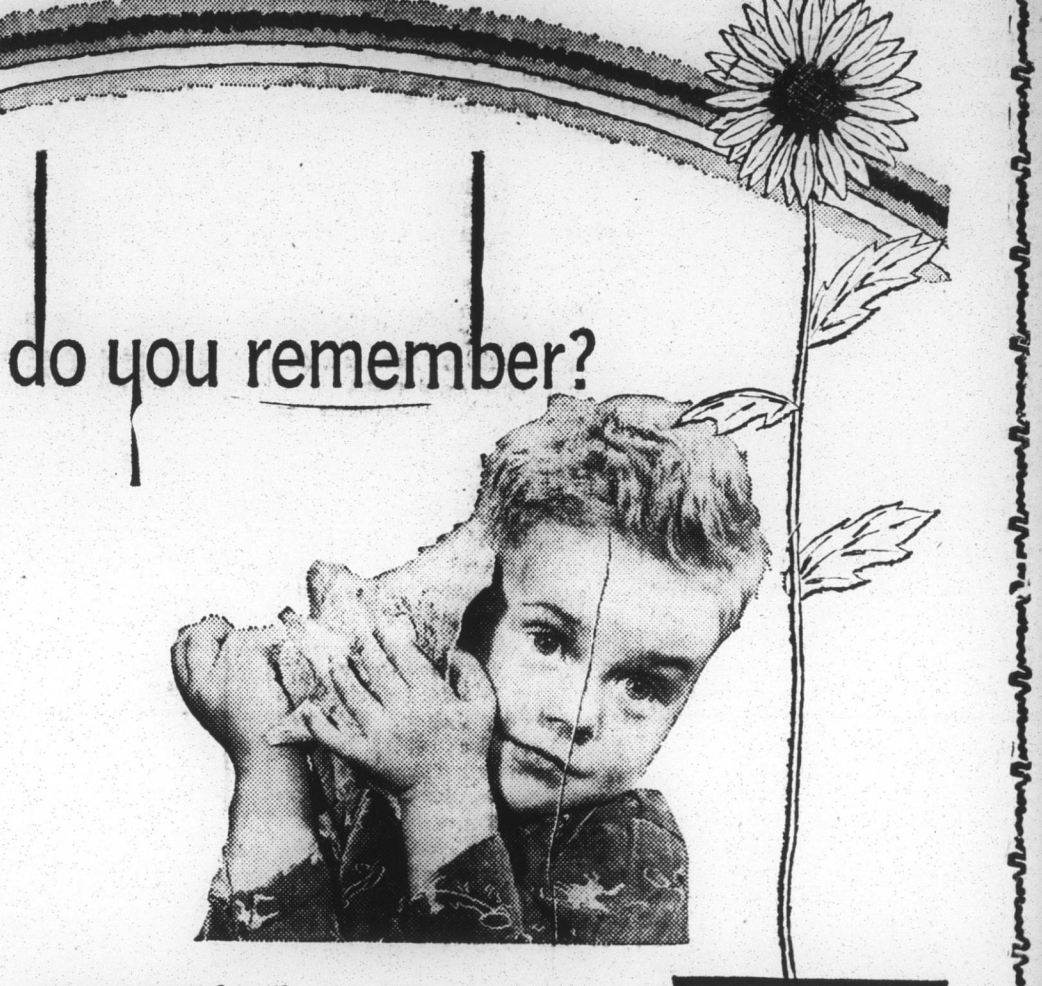
Let's go to Church Sunday Sunday School Lesson
