Three From Edenton Named On Democratic Registration Group

Richard D. Dixon, Jr., James M. Bond and Mrs. L. E. Davenport of Edenton have been named to serve on the Democratic Registration for Chowan County, according to an announcement by State Democratic Party Chairman Bert L. Bennett. The statewide committee is headed by Chairman John R. Jenkins, Jr., of Aulander. Tom H. Shepard of Edenton is chairman of the committee for the First Congressional District. In announcing these appointments, Bennett stated that the purpose of the Registration Committee is to get all voting age persons registered, with special emphasis on young voters, unregistered women, those who are not registered in the precincts where they are now living, and those persons who have registered for municipal elections and are under the mistaken idea that they are also registered for county and state elections. "Our registration drive is one part of the great movement of the Democratic Party in North Carolina to broaden the base and increase the margin of Democratic voters in the State," said Bennett. "In undertaking this comprehensive registration drive," he continued, "we are seeking to build party harmony and solidarity for the fall campaign."
