

## District Sanitarian Emphasizes Ordinance For Trailer Parking

K. J. Eyer, sanitarian for the District Health Department, calls attention to the trailer parking ordinance which was adopted in 1957.

"Sanitation, as related to the operation of trailer parking," says Mr. Eyer, "requires more than a clean, comfortable and attractive mobile home. It involves a safe water supply, approved disposal of sewage, trash and garbage disposal, adequate lighting, as well as insect and rodent control. There is a definite need for general guidance in the planning and operation of trailer courts, so the construction, operation and maintenance of these areas will comply with health regulations, thus being satisfactory to individuals using courts, the court owners, and the residents of adjacent areas."

"Due to the anticipated influx of military and civilian personnel at Naval Air Facility, Harvey's Point, Hertford, the District Board of Health adopted a trailer parking ordinance in 1957. This ordinance has been recently amended to satisfactorily cover the larger mobile homes now being used."

The Health District ordinance defines a trailer court as any lot of ground upon which two or more trailer coaches occupied for dwelling or sleeping purposes are located. Each trailer parking space must have a minimum of 2,400 square feet of space. An inspection of proposed site and a permit prior to construction of trailer court are necessary. It is, therefore, requested that any person or persons considering to construct a trailer court, or parking individual trailers, first contact the local health department.

"The Health District's Septic Tank Ordinance covers the sewage disposal for individual trailer

er parking. Many trailers have one, two or three bedrooms, therefore, an adequate septic tank installation is necessary. Some persons are found who connect a trailer with a home system only to be inviting trouble by overloading the system."

## Edenton Forester On European Tour

It is announced by E. R. Foster, executive director, that the 17-day U. S. Foresters Tour of Europe has exceeded the expectation of every member of the 40 man group. Sponsored by the Connecticut River Watershed Council of Greenfield, Mass., this is the first large contingent of foresters to pay a visit to Europe since 1935. Visits were made to Germany, Austria, Switzerland and Sweden.

Examples of multi purpose forestry methods, research and watershed management along with large scale pulp and lumber operations were on the itinerary. Conceived as an example of people to people contact with European foresters, Foster said the association, fellowship and cooperation the group received from federal state, industry and local foresters was a good example of "Common Market" exchange.

Arrangements were made with members of the German Forestry Association for a return tour visit in 1963 of the eastern seaboard of U. S. by members of this organization.

Foster said the council would continue to sponsor these educational trips to see Europe's fine forests and to afford others the opportunity to meet European officials.

The hotel and other tourist arrangements were handled by the Primus Travel Organisation, Frankfurt.

Among those U. S. foresters on the tour was James E. Hobbs, consultant forester of Edenton.

The forester tour left Frankfurt on October 20 by Lufthansa 190 for New York.
