

### Aces Drop First Conference Game To Bertie High

### Local Boys Lose 43 to 45 In Overtime Contest Played In Aulander Gymnasium

Edenton's Aces played their first conference game with Bertie High School and lost in an overtime game 43 to 45, played in a small overcrowded gymnasium at Aulander.

The Aces jumped to a lead of 12 to 1 as Melvin Barnett hit his first four shots. At the end of the first quarter the Aces led 18 to 5. Then Bertie started pressing and continued the press until the end of the game. With such a small gym and with fans on all sides of the court the press was very effective. With the press bothering the Aces and with an advantage of height, Bertie gained on the Aces and cut their lead to 23 to 15 at the half.

During the second half, height of Bertie players dominated the boards and kept the Aces from second shots. Also Melvin Barnett was held to only 6 points the second half, whereas he scored 10 points the first quarter.

With these facts and the press, Bertie gained on the Aces and tied the game 41 to 41 at the end of regulation time. The Aces had a chance of winning before regulation time was over but could not get a shot away.

In the overtime Bertie scored 4 points and the Aces could score

High scorer for the Aces was Melvin Barnett with 16 points. Following Barnett was Douglas Sexton with 9 points, Bill Erwin with 6 points, Douglas Twiddy 8 points, and Dwight Flanagan with 4 points. David Holton had a sprained ankle but played a few minutes in the fourth quarter.

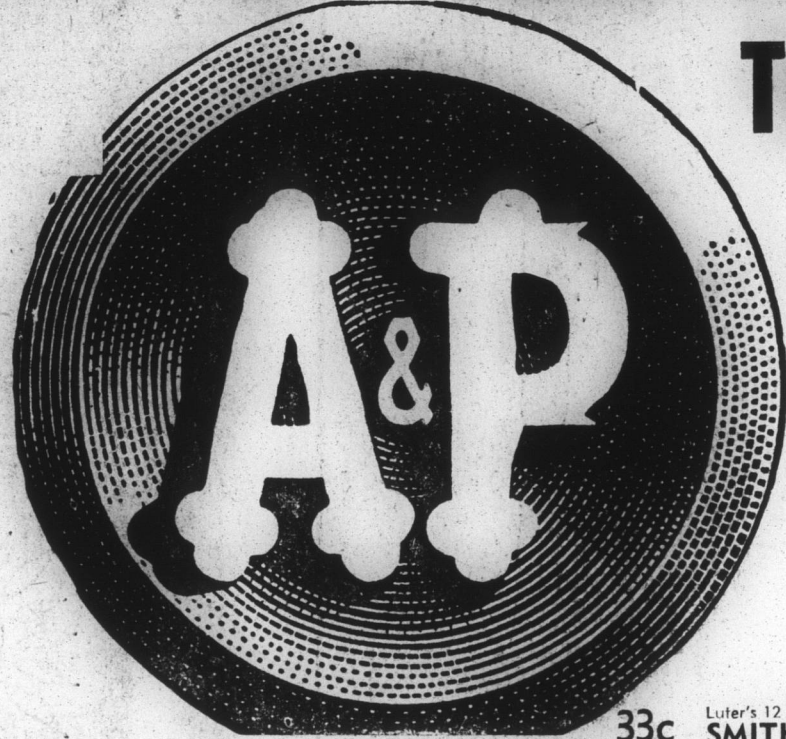

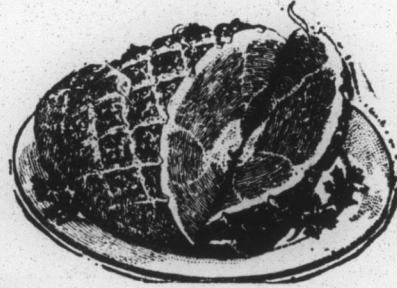
