

Veterans' Corner

Veterans Employment
During fiscal year 1964 veterans filed 24,479 applications for work at the 54 local State Employment offices in North Carolina. This represented 18.83 per cent of all new job allocations filed by men, but they obtained more than 22.18 per cent of all non-farm job placements. Thus in term of preference, veterans accounted for nearly 1 out of 6 new applications of men and 1 out of 5 non-farm placements of male job seekers. Disabled veterans represented 37.27 per cent of all the handicapped men who sought jobs through the public employment service, but

were placed in 45.51 per cent of the jobs filled by handicapped males.
Our local office, which serves Chowan, Gates, Perquimans and Tyrrell Counties, reported 13 per cent of all males hired through the office during November were veterans. The national goal in placements of veterans is 30 per cent. If a veteran needs help in finding work, do him a real favor and send him to the Veterans Employment representative at the local Employment Office.

War I Veteran mean?
A.—A person who served in the armed forces during the period, beginning on April 6, 1917, and ending on November 11, 1918, and in the case of a veteran who served with the United States military forces in Russia, means the period beginning on April 6, 1917, and ending on April 1, 1920. Service after November 11, 1918, and before July 2, 1921, is considered World War I service if the veteran served in the active military, naval or air service after April 5, 1917 and before November 12, 1918.
Q. What does the VA do about my GI insurance if my wife and I should die? It would go to my children but they are too young to handle it.
A. The VA legal division

would appoint a guardian to handle this as well as any VA pension to which the children might be entitled.
Q. I understand that a disabled veteran has preference in employment by the federal government and many states and cities. How do I go about establishing this preference?
A. If you were retired for disability by the armed forces, your service can furnish you proof. If you have established your disability as service-connected with the VA, the regional office which has your records can furnish you the appropriate certification.
