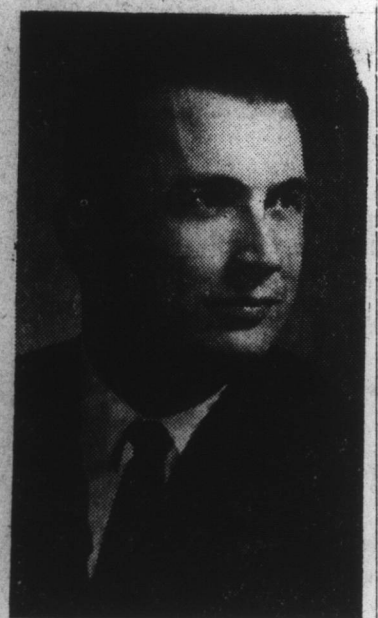
The Royal Ambassadors will distribute to all of the homes in the community door knob envelopes, which will include a personal invitation for each family to attend the revival and also several tracts.
