European Tour Is Taking Shape

"Albemarle Abroad - Europe In 1966" is the title of a trip being sponsored this summer by the College of the Albemarle of Elizabeth City.

J. Tivis Wicker, GOA director of adult education and community service, said this week a number of reservations already have been received for the 22-day tour.

"A considerable amount of local and area interest has been expressed and the group size is to be limited, therefore, all interested parties should confirm their reservations with deposits as soon as possible," he said.

The group will leave New York on July 14 and return on August 4. Total cost of the trip is \$739, which is the lowest group rate. The fare includes round-trip jet flights from New York, first class hotel, and rail accommodations, most meals, sight seeing and other items.

The return flight will be direct from Rome.

"A member of the COA staff will accompany the group and a professional guide will be on the tour constantly.

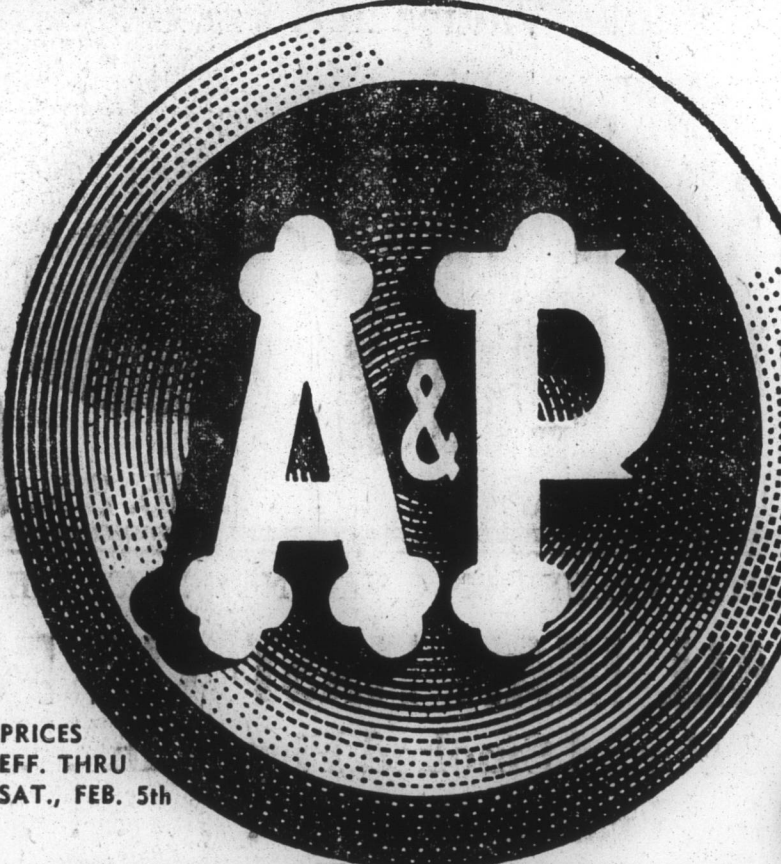

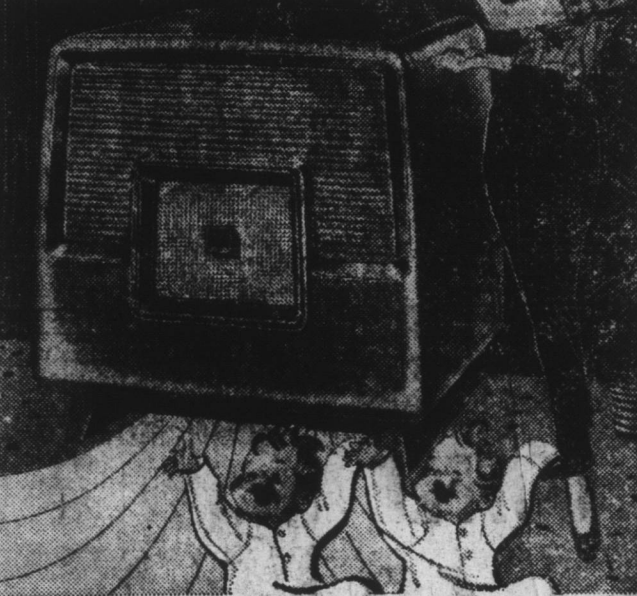
